

Notes from Kimba Museum

We have a new addition to the museum grounds, a Tractor Shed that was finished earlier this year, it is between two of the Government Sheds at Kimba Museum. The Tractor shed will house all of the historical tractors that have been kindly gifted over a number of years. These tractors demonstrate the changes in style, methods and horsepower since the early settlers started agriculture, developing their lands from virgin scrub to productive enterprises in the Kimba district.

This project has been made possible with a lot of hard work and fund raising by the members of the museum and a grant awarded by the History Trust South Australia.

By having this shed erected it will allow the volunteers to showcase the tractor collection and other machinery items in a more orderly and spacious manner, making it safer for visitors to be educated, and creating an enjoyable and long-lasting experience. It will also add another experience for returning visitors to the museum.
