An iteration of the award-winning history drama Of Auburn for **Students of Humanities** will be performed during History Month in May 2024.

Of Auburn combines theatre, poetry, personal testimony, music and immersive audio-visual technology to tell the stories of volunteer nurses in World War I through the real-life character of Madge Yeatman. These stories, drawn from diaries and letters, are interweaved with the life and war-time poetry of CJ Dennis.

The title bears the name of the birthplace in South Australia of both Yeatman and Dennis and the writings of South Australian volunteer nurses Anne Donnell and Olive Haynes are also featured.
