Fellowships

The Friends in our 27th year, is pleased to announce two small Fellowships of \$250, named to recognize its former President, Jack Cross AM. The Fellowship is awarded annually to small history projects or to support students of South Australian history, who are pursuing a dedicated program of historical research in archives and history, with a focus in the use of South Australian archival resources. Fellowships may be used for travel expenses to access records or put towards the photocopying or digitising of archival material. While the Friends are flexible as to how the Fellowship is used, the research focus must be on South Australia and its associated archival records. The recipients will be required to provide a short article for the FSAA newsletter on their research project.
